Courtesy Boat Inspectors

- Prevent harmful invasive species attached to boats and trailers from entering lakes.
- Educate boaters about the threats of invasive species.
- Work outdoors at public boat launches on Androscoggin Lake, Flying Pond, Minnehonk Lake and Parker Pond
- Memorial Day to Labor Day.

Youth Conservation Corps

- Protect lake water quality through projects that reduce erosion and polluted stormwater runoff
- Install conservation practices like planting shrubs, building paths, and stabilizing shorelines.
- Work outdoors and learn handson skills.
- 6 weeks (late June-early August).

Invasive Plant Surveyor

- Survey by kayak the lakes and ponds in the 30 Mile River Watershed for invasive aquatic plants.
- Assist SCUBA divers in removing invasive milfoil by providing surface support.
- Collect and report data on invasive aquatic plants.
- 12 weeks, late May to mid-August.
